POSSIBLE CONDITIONS OF BAIL AGREEMENTS

TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS



The defendant may be barred from traveling outside a designated area, such as leaving the state or city, to prevent flight risk.

NO CONTACT ORDERS



The defendant may be required to avoid contact with specific people, such as alleged victims or witnesses, to prevent intimidation.

DRIVING PROHIBITION



The defendant may be restricted from driving, often in cases involving DUI or reckless driving.

ALCOHOL PROHIBITION



The defendant may be prohibited from consuming alcohol or entering bars, especially in alcohol-related offenses.

REGULAR CHECK-INS



The defendant must report regularly to a court officer, ensuring compliance with bail terms and court appearance.

CURFEW ENFORCEMENT



The defendant may have a curfew, limiting movement during certain hours, reducing risks of reoffending.

MANDATORY DRUG TESTING



The defendant may need to take regular drug tests, ensuring sobriety in drugrelated cases.
